LAMANA INSTRUCTION



HAT #06/03

SIZE M (54–57 cm)

MATERIALS Lamana Como (100% Merino Superfine, approx. 120 m/25 g) 50 g in colour Slate Grey shade 28M, 3.5 mm and 4 mm knitting needles, 6 stitch markers, tapestry needle

PATTERN NOTE Rib Pattern: RS rows: k 1, p 1; WS rows: knit sts as they appear Main Pattern: seed stitch (even number of sts): Row 1 (RS): *k 1, p 1, repeat from * to end of row Row 2 (WS): *p 1, k 1, repeat from * to end of row. Repeat rows 1 and 2. Gauge: 23 sts and 40 rows in seed st with 4 mm needles (lightly stretched) = 10 x 10 cm

HOW TO Cast on 122 sts using 3.5 mm needles and work in rib for 12 rows (3 cm). Change to 4 mm needles and continue in seed st for further 18 cm. In following RS row work 10 sts in pattern, place marker, then place marker every 20 sts 5 times more. Continue in pattern and at the marked places work tog 3 sts every 6th row (3 times), then every 4th row (6 times).

Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread through remaining 14 sts and pull tight.

TO FINISH Weave in ends and join back seam. Let piece dry under wet cloth.
